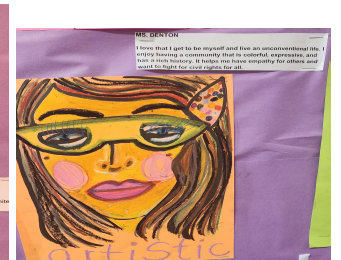
MANNY
Love being myself + not being ashamed.



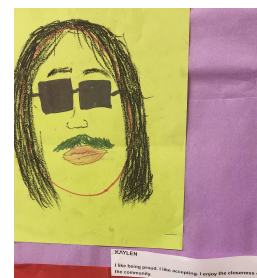
MR. JEREMY
