DUAL ENROLLMENT

The Dual Enrollment Program at the City Colleges of Chicago allows motivated rising high school juniors and seniors the opportunity to earn college credit, while attending high school. Students enroll in college courses through one of the seven City Colleges & they may enroll in one (1) college course per semester. Course instruction occurs on the CCC campuses. The credits students earn are transferable to many four-year colleges and universities. Students in Dual Enrollment frequently enroll in English, Mathematics, World Languages, Science & Literature. Students can also enroll in career pathway courses, including Automotive, Business, Early Childhood Development, Logistics and Information Technology.

REQUIREMENTS:

- Be a rising junior or senior in high school (for summer 2021)
- Have a minimum G.P.A. of 2.5 & a 90% attendance rate

ADVANTAGES OF DUAL ENROLLMENT

- Earn credit for both high school and college. The college credit will be applied to a degree program at one of the City Colleges of Chicago or can be transferred to a four-year college
- Get access to great college professors.
- Develop important time management and study skills.
- Reduce the time and money you will spend in college.
- Strengthen your college applications by demonstrating readiness for college.
- "Try on" a major with courses related to intended major.
- Get to your major FASTER by completing some of your general education requirements prior to college.
- Get a true college experience. Not only will you be taking college level courses alongside traditional college students as a participant in the program, you will have access to all CCC resources such as the computer labs, symposia, library and the gymnasium.
